3: Composition/information on ingredients

A mixture of anionic and non-ionic surface-active agents, stabilising agents, alkalis, non-phosphate detergent builders and sequestering agents, in an aqueous base.

- Contains 0.5%-2% Potassium Hydroxide (KOH) - CAS No. 1310-58-3

4: First aid measures

Description of necessary first-aid measures

General advice

Advice to Doctor: Burns are not immediately painful, onset of pain may be minutes to hours.

If inhaled

If inhaled, remove from contaminated area to fresh air immediately. Apply artificial respiration if not breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Immediately medical attention is required.

In case of skin contact

Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with water for at least 15 minutes. Ensure contaminated clothing is washed before re-use. Seek medical advice /attention depending on the severity.

In case of eye contact

If in eyes, hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water. Continue flushing until advised to stop by the Poisons Information Centre or a doctor, or for at least 15 minutes. Seek immediate medical assistance.

If swallowed

Rinse mouth thoroughly with water immediately, repeat until all traces of product have been removed. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Seek immediate medical advice.

5: Firefighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media

Small fire

Use dry chemical, CO2 or water spray.

Large fire

Use water spray, fog or foam - Do NOT use water jets.

If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from the fire area. Cool containers with flooding quantities of water until well after the fire is out. Avoid getting water inside the containers.

Specific hazards arising from the chemical

Hazards from Combustion Products: May liberate toxic fumes in fire (Carbon and potassium oxides).

Material does not burn. Fire or heat will produce irritating, poisonous and/or corrosive gases. Contact with metals may evolve flammable hydrogen gas.

Special protective actions for fire-fighters

Wear SCBA and chemical splash suit. Fully encapsulating, gas-tight suits should be worn for maximum protection. Structural firefighter's uniform is NOT effective for these materials.

Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Evacuate the area of all non-essential personnel. Avoid inhalation, contact with skin, eyes and clothing.

Wear protective clothing specified for normal operations (see Section 8)

Methods and materials for containment and cleaning up

Clean-up Methods - Large Spillages:

Do NOT touch or walk through this product. Do NOT touch damaged containers or spilled material unless wearing appropriate protective clothing. Stop leak if safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, confined areas.

7: Handling and storage

Precautions for safe handling

Avoid generation or accumulation of dusts. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin and eyes. Wash hands and face thoroughly after working with material. Contaminated clothing should be removed and washed before reuse. Use in well-ventilated areas. In case of insufficient ventilation, wear suitable respiratory equipment.

Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Corrosiveness: Corrosive to aluminium, tin, copper and zinc. Corrosive to steel at elevated temperatures.
